CITY OF BUFFALO SMART STREETS DESIGN PLAN: The Smart Streets Design Plan examines ways to technologically enhance the roadways in Downtown Buffalo to better accommodate a wide range of modes of transportation including e-bikes, e-scooters, smart cars, electric charging stations, curbside charging and more.

CITY OF BUFFALO DOWNTOWN WATERFRONT IMPROVEMENT PLAN: The Downtown Waterfront Plan aims to better connect residents and visitors to downtown's waterfront area making it easier for them to access the attractions and sights available by improving roadways, trails, parks, lighting and more. The design plan will develop public realm improvements from Downtown Buffalo's waterfront to Ralph Wilson Park. The goal is to produce a master plan to improve connectivity, attractiveness, investment, and the overall quality of life for employees, residents and visitors in an equitable way.
