PUBLIC NOTICE

The U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration (EDA) is considering a request for Federal assistance from the Buffalo Urban Development Corporation to undertake the Northland Redevelopment Corridor, Phase 3 Project in Buffalo, Erie County, New York State. Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA), EDA is conducting an assessment of the potential of the proposed project to affect the environment and/or historic properties.

The project involves rehabilitation/reuse of existing buildings in the Northland Redevelopment Corridor (AKA Northland "Campus") along Northland Avenue, between Fillmore Avenue and Grider Street; improvements to an existing parking lot and creation of a new parking lot for tenants/visitors; and installation of components at a proposed Campus electrical microgrid consisting of upgrades to an existing electrical substation and installation of rooftop solar arrays/battery backup systems at existing buildings. These project components will be located at: 537 East Delavan Avenue; 683 and 612 Northland Avenue; an existing parking lot at 714 Northland Avenue; vacant land adjoining 683 Northland Avenue; and at an electrical substation at 644 Northland Avenue.
